22. LEADING REIN BEST RIDER

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

23. FIRST RIDDEN

Pony not exceeding 132cms. Riders 11 years or under.

Mini Championship to follow for 1st & 2nd place from classes 21 - 23

24. RIDDEN NOVICE

Combination not to have been placed 1st previously in a showing class

25. RIDDEN COLOURED

26. MIXED M&M (ALL BREEDS) CONFINED NOVICE

Not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M class at any show before 1st January

27. OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

The judge will take a short break after class 27
Class 28 will not start before 1pm

28. RIDING CLUB HORSE

To include one jump in individual show

29. RIDING HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)

30. RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS - Pure or part-bred non-native breeds

31. SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)

32. RIDDEN VETERAN – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP
