24. LEADING REIN BEST RIDER

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

25a. FIRST RIDDEN 25a & b will be amalgamated if less than 3 entries per section

Pony not exceeding 132cms. Riders 11 years or under

27. RIDDEN COLOURED

28. WORKING COLOURED

To include one jump in individual show (height of jump can be altered)

29. RIDING CLUB HORSE or PONY

To include one jump in individual show (height of jump can be altered)

The judge will take a short break after class 29

Class 30 will not start before 1pm

30. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

30b. FANCY DRESS (Wednesday 8th August ONLY)

31. RIDING HORSE or PONY

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)

32. RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS - Pure or part-bred non-native breeds

33. SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)

34. RIDDEN VETERAN – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

Riders any age. Complete novices only!!

10. **YOUNGSTOCK** *Sponsored by AJ's Feed & Bedding (5th May)*

11. **BEST COLOURED HORSE/PONY (IN-HAND)**

Paints, spots, roans, duns, palominos, skewbald and piebald

13. **MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (IN-HAND)**

May be split into Small & Large breeds (pure or part-bred)

15. **LOCAL HORSE / PONY (IN-HAND)** – Kept within 25 miles
