## 9am prompt:

### 23. LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

### 24. LEADING REIN BEST RIDER

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

### 25. FIRST RIDDEN

Pony not exceeding 132cms. Riders 12 years or under.

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP** to follow for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place from classes 23-25

### 26. RIDDEN NOVICE

Combination not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> in a showing class before 2017

### 27. RIDDEN COLOURED – Rider may be led

### 28. RIDDEN COB / COB TYPE

### 29. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

**The judge will take a short break after class 29  
Class 30 will not start before 12.30pm**

### 30. RIDING CLUB HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

To include one small fence in individual show

### 31. RIDING/SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring)

### 32. RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS - Pure or part-bred non-native breeds

### 33. RIDDEN LOCAL HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

Any h/p which is kept within 25 miles of showground

### 34. RIDDEN VETERAN – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP

Riders may be led – two phase. Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> (jump off timed) Genuine absolute novice's ONLY please!

Open to any horse or pony 3 years & under. Rosette to 'Best Yearling'

### 10. BEST COLOURED HORSE/PONY (IN-HAND)

Paints, spots, roans, duns, palominos, skewbald and piebald

### 11. SHOW RING EXPERIENCE (IN-HAND)

For horses/ponies not previously placed 1<sup>st</sup> in a showing class

### 12. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (IN-HAND)

May be split into Small & Large breeds

### 13. FOREIGN BREEDS (IN-HAND) – Pure or part-bred non-native breeds

### 14. JUNIOR HANDLER (IN-HAND) - Handler 16yrs & under

### 15. HORSE/PONY 4yrs & OVER – Open to any horse or pony 4yrs +

The judge will take a short break after class 15

Class 16 will not start before 12noon

### 16. MOST HANDSOME GELDING/COLT/STALLION
