## 9am prompt:

### 23. LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

### 24. LEADING REIN BEST RIDER

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

### 25. FIRST RIDDEN

Pony not exceeding 132cms. Riders 12 years or under.

### 25b. JUNIOR RIDDEN (WILL NOT CANTER AS A GROUP)

Pony not exceeding 148cms. Riders 14 years or under. May be led.

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP** to follow for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place from classes 23-25b

### 26. RIDDEN NOVICE

Combination not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> previously in a showing class  
(WILL NOT CANTER AS A GROUP)

### 27. RIDDEN COLOURED

### 28. RIDDEN COB / COB TYPE

### 29. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND

The judge will take a short break after class 29  
Class 30 will not start before 12.30pm

### 30. RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY — Rider may be led

To include one small fence in individual show

### 31. RIDING HORSE or PONY — Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)

### 32. RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS - Pure or part-bred non-native breeds

### 33. SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY — Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring at 15hh)

### 34. RIDDEN VETERAN — Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP

9am prompt:

**9. YOUNGSTOCK**

Open to any horse or pony 3 years & under. Rosette to 'Best Yearling'

**10. BEST COLOURED HORSE/PONY (IN-HAND)**

Paints, spots, roans, duns, palominos, skewbald and piebald

**11. SHOW RING EXPERIENCE (IN-HAND)**

For horses/ponies not previously placed 1<sup>st</sup> in a showing class

**12. FOREIGN BREEDS (IN-HAND)** – Pure or part-bred non-native

breeds

**13. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (IN-HAND)**

May be split into Small & Large breeds (pure or part-bred)

**14. JUNIOR HANDLER (IN-HAND)** - Handler 16yrs & under

**15. HORSE/PONY 4yrs & OVER** – Open to any horse or pony 4yrs +

The judge will take a short break after class 15

Class 16 will not start before 12.30pm

**16. IN-HAND GELDING/COLT/STALLION**

**17. BEST VETERAN (IN-HAND)** – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

**18. BEST PONY (IN-HAND)**

**19. BEST HORSE (IN-HAND)**

**20. LOCAL HORSE/PONY (IN-HAND)**

Any h/p which is kept within 25 miles of showground

**21. IN-HAND MARE**
