

## SHOW INFORMATION

The cross country course is available to walk on Friday 27th July from 2-7pm (other times may be available by arrangement) and on Saturday from 7.30am – 8.45am. For those who cannot make either of these times and are jumping later on Saturday we will organise a course walk time for you at approx. 1.30pm -2pm. We regret that due to safety we are not able to allow course walking while the competition is underway.

Show Jumping can be walked throughout the day at the start of each batch of riders (riders are batched in one hour groups). Please ask the ring steward for further information.

The dressage times are set every 7 minutes but for the show jumping and cross country you have been issued with a time slot (most are one hour). Please make sure you declare to the relevant ring steward to put your number on the board in sufficient time that you will be able to jump in your allocated slot.

Cross country is judged with an optimum time (set at a steady hunting canter). Faults will be awarded as 20 for the first refusal, 40 for the second refusal and an elimination for 3 refusals or a fall. In the event of an elimination you will be asked to leave the course at the nearest exit (on foot, leading the horse if it was a rider fall). This will be indicated by a whistle blown by the nearest jump judge. A time limit of 20 seconds will be allowed for horse and rider to enter the water before it will be deemed a refusal and you will be asked to move onto the next fence.

Riders must wear a body protector and hat without a fixed peak for the cross country.

**Riders must wear their numbers on their backs. Please collect your number from the secretary when you arrive on the day.**

Classes 1 & 2 will be split into section A & B (15 riders per section) with rosettes awarded in each section. A cup will be presented to the best score in each class.

Pairs will be judged by the same rules and optimum time. Riders may choose to go side by side or one behind the other but the time will start/stop when the first rider starts and the second rider finishes.

OPTIONAL WATER – the water will be optional for all classes. There will be an alternative LONGER route for those who either choose not to attempt the water OR those who incur faults at the water and are unable to go through it
