Combination not to have been placed 1st OR are in their first season of showing

12. BEST COB/COB TYPE (IN-HAND)

13. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (IN-HAND)

May be split into Small & Large breeds (pure or part-bred)

14. JUNIOR HANDLER (IN-HAND) - Handler 16yrs & under

15. HORSE/PONY 4yrs & OVER – Open to any horse or pony 4yrs +

TSR SOUTH EAST SHOWING FINALS

Finals are open to qualified handlers/riders who hold a TSR or Equifest qualification card. Cards MUST be shown to the steward on entering the ring.

RIDERS MUST NOT HAVE QUALIFIED FOR HOYS IN 2017/2018 TO BE ELIGIBLE

Riders/Handlers DO NOT have to be a TSR Member to compete.

GET YOUR TSR SASH! All TSR Members in each FINAL will receive a TSR Members Sash

Who Can Enter? The finals are open to riders/ handlers who have qualified and hold a TSR card or a signed 2018 Equifest Card. Riders MUST not have qualified for HOYS in 2017/2018. You need to show the card to the steward when you enter the ring so make sure you take a COPY of your Equifest Card before you send in your entries for these shows.

What Classes can I enter? The RIDER/HANDLER has qualified and can enter ANY of the TSR Finals on any horse/pony (it does not have to be the pony/horse they qualified on).

Do I need to be a TSR Member? You DO NOT have to be a TSR to enter.

How do I Enter? Entries go to the show hosting the final not to TSR. Either enter before the show by online or post OR enter on the day, DO NOT send the card in when entering, carry the card in your pocket during the class and show to the steward at the ring.

How are the FINALS judged? The TSR Finals will be judged using the following Mark System. The Performance Judge will award up to 30 Marks for Performance & up to 30 marks for the Riders/Handlers Skill. The conformation judge will award up to 30 marks for Conformation & 10 for Turnout.

Class 36 **TSR Riding Club / Competition Horse/Pony Final**

4 years & over, any type, rider any age to be suitably mounted. To be judged on the suitability of the horse/pony as a good all rounder, will not be required to jump. Open to qualified riders who hold a TSR or Equifest card. *Highest placed TSR Member goes forward for TSR Members Supreme Championship Rosettes Galore!!!! 1st Rosettes to the highest placed horse/pony & Junior Rider*

Class 37 **TSR Veteran / Senior Horse or Pony Final**

4 years old & over, any height, any type. Horses to be 15 years & over. Riders any age to be suitably mounted. Open to qualified riders who hold a TSR or Equifest card. *Class will be split for the go round, lead reins eligible. Highest placed TSR Member goes forward to TSR Members Supreme Championship. Rosettes Galore!!!! 1st Rosettes to the highest placed 15-18yrs, 19-24yrs & 24 yrs+. Rosette to highest placed Junior Rider.*

Class 38 **TSR Equitation Junior & Senior - TSR Members Only - Sashes to All Members - No Qualification required including Talent Spotting for the**

TSR Training Pathway Any age Rider suitably mounted on any type/age/sex of horse/pony. To be judged on the riders ability and the performance & presentation of the horse/pony, conformation will not be taken into account. Riders to be 16 years & over at time of entry, suitably mounted. *Highest placed TSR Member goes forward for TSR Members Supreme Championship.
