38-41 Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective societies. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4yrs old and over. Rider any age.

### 38. MIXED M&M (ALL BREEDS) CONFINED NOVICE

Stallion, mare or gelding not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M class at any show before 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year. Rider any age

### 39. RIDDEN SMALL M&M

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B – SMALL BREEDS

### 40. RIDDEN LARGE M&M – will be amalgamated with 39 if less than 4 entries each

Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D – LARGE BREEDS

### 41. JUNIOR RIDDEN M&M

Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A,B,C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January.

### 42. WALK & TROT RIDDEN NOVICE HORSE / PONY

Not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize of £10 or more in a ridden showing class. Will not canter as a group

### 44. COLOURED HORSE (RIDDEN)

Open ridden piebald or skewbald, roan, dun, spot or palomino, mare, gelding or stallion – over 148cms

### 45. COLOURED PONY (RIDDEN) - will be amalgamated with 44 if less than 4 entries

Open ridden piebald or skewbald, roan, dun, spot or palomino, mare, gelding or stallion – up to 148cms

### 46. SHOW HUNTER HORSE / PONY (RIDDEN)

Open ridden hunter, mare or gelding, 4yrs or over. Rider any age

### 47. RIDING HORSE / PONY (RIDDEN)

Open ridden hunter, mare or gelding, 4yrs or over. Rider any age

### 48. WORKING COLOURED

Same rules as class 44 & 45 – to include one small fence in individual show

### 49. RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY (RIDDEN)

31. **CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE (RIDDEN)**

32. **TINY TOTS LEAD REIN**  
Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 6<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.  
**Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> and additional 'special' rosettes to all unplaced exhibits**
33. **LEAD REIN PONY**  
Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.  
**Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> and additional 'special' rosettes to all unplaced exhibits**
34. **LEADING REIN BEST RIDER**  
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead to be attached to noseband.
35. **FIRST RIDDEN PONY**  
First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, Riders not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.
36. **FIRST RIDDEN – BEST RIDER**  
Riders not to have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in current year
37. **JUNIOR RIDER**  
Pony not exceeding 152cms. Riders 16 years or under. May be led. Will not canter as a group.
