

RING 3 ~ RIDDEN SHOWING

All classes £13.00 each if entered via Equo (otherwise £14)

JUDGE: JAMIE SHEEHY

24. TINY TOTS LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 7 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband.

24b. ABSOLUTE NOVICE LEAD REIN

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. GENUINE ABSOLUTE NOVICES ONLY PLEASE!

25. LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband.

26. JUNIOR RIDDEN (Will not canter as a group)

Pony not exceeding 148cms. Riders 16 years or under.

27. WALK & TROT NOVICE - May be split into junior/senior if entries permit

Open to any novice showing combination inc. lead rein & first ridden. Walk & trot only inc. individual show. Riders may enter both 27 & 28

28. RIDDEN NOVICE (Will not canter as a group)

Combination not to have been placed 1st in a showing class before 2024

28b. CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE – Rider may be led *(added by request)*

29. RIDDEN COLOURED – Rider may be led

30. RIDDEN COB / COB TYPE – Rider may be led

31. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Rider may be led

32. RIDING/SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring)

33. RIDDEN VETERAN – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP

34. RIDING CLUB HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Will include one small fence in individual show

RING 1 ~ SHOW JUMPING

Approx. 9am – 9.30am Clear Round (Cross Poles)
£6 per round

1a. Cross Poles Jumping (Double Clear)

Riders may be led – Two Phase. All double clears equal 1st (jump off not timed). Genuine absolute novices only.

1b. Cross Poles (Timed)

Riders may enter A & B
Riders may be led – Two Phase. Jump-Off timed

2. Horse & Groom (Bottom Hole/Cross Poles)

Riders may be led. Rider jumps fences 1-8, then groom jumps 1-5 on foot. Fastest clear wins!

3. Bottom Hole Absolute Novice Jumping

Riders any age. Complete novices Only

4. 30-40cm Absolute Novice Jumping

Riders any age. Complete novices Only

5. 40-50cm Mini Jumping

6. 60cm Small Open Jumping

7. 70cm Jumping - Sponsored by Quantum Photographic

8. 75cm Small Intermediate

9. 80cm Intermediate Jumping

10. 85-90cm Small Open Jumping

11. 90-95cm Large Open Jumping

12. YOUNGSTOCK

Open to any horse or pony 3 years & under. Rosette to 'Best Yearling'

13. IN-HAND COLOURED

14. SHOW RING EXPERIENCE (IN-HAND)

For horses/ponies not placed 1st in a showing class before 2024

15. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (IN-HAND)

May be split into Small & Large breeds

16. BEST VETERAN (IN-HAND) – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

17. JUNIOR HANDLER (IN-HAND) - Handler 16yrs & under

18. IN-HAND PONY

19. IN-HAND GELDING/COLT/STALLION

20. IN-HAND MARE

21. SHETLAND / MINIATURE PONY

22. COB / COB TYPE IN-HAND

23. CONDITION & TURNOUT IN-HAND
