1. Cross Poles Jumping (Double Clear)

Riders may be led – Two Phase. All double clears equal 1st (jump off not timed). Genuine absolute novices only.

1b. Cross Poles RIDE & RUN

Riders may be led – Two Phase. Rider jumps fences 1-8 then dismounts and jumps 'jump off' on foot. Fastest clear wins!

All classes are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any colour and one parent must be a traditional gypsy cob

25. TGCA PB In-Hand Open to fillies, colts and geldings aged 1, 2 and 3 Years old & mares, geldings and stallions 4 years old and over. Mixed height. Native/Non-Native (plaited/hogged).

<u>Go for Glory (GOG) Championship – Part Bred Traditional Gypsy Cobs</u>

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA part bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. For 2024 TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. **Youngstock and Seniors may be split for Go for Glory Championship purposes with a separate Championship for each section.** The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award - Part Bred Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Part Bred Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Part Bred Traditional Gelding. The judge will award this within the classes/championship

26. TINY TOTS LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 7 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband.

27. LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband.

- **28. JUNIOR RIDDEN** (Will not canter as a group) Pony not exceeding 148cms. Riders 16 years or under.
- **29. FIRST RIDDEN** (Will not canter as a group) Pony not exceeding 134cms. Riders 12 years or under.

- **36. RIDING/SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY** Rider may be led Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring)
- **37. RIDDEN VETERAN** Open to any horse or pony 15yrs + Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP
- **38. RIDING CLUB HORSE or PONY** Rider may be led Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Will include one small fence in individual show

Both TGCA Championships (Quest for a Star and Go for Glory) will take place in Ring 3 after classes 40 & 41 (inc. winners from 24 & 25)

SSADL LIHS DIRECT ROUTE QUALIFIERS

DIRECT ROUTE QUALFIERS – Are open to Members and Non-members HOWEVER, to claim the LIHS ticket a competitor MUST already be a 2025 member. The members MUST produce the membership card or a covering letter from the SSADL Show office to be able to claim the LIHS Ticket.

The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same for the Grand Final. No substitutions will be accepted. For a competitor to be eligible to compete at the LIHS Senior Showing Grand Final at the XCELL, ALL ponies/horses MUST meet the current FEI Vaccination Regulations.

NOTE -ONCE A COMPETITOR HAS QUALIFIED FOR LIHS IN THE RIDDEN SECTION, THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO QUALIFY IN THE IN-HAND SECTION AND VICE VERSA.

Competitors MUST produce both the above cards at the ring side before entry NO CARDS NO ENTRY No Spurs with the exception to senior side saddle riders. No Galloping or canter extensions. No Wearing of Face/Body Jewellery with the exception to the ear ring used by competitors with health problems. Foals are NOT permitted SSADL Classes. For In-Hand Classes- Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein & First Ridden competitors: Strip section both lead rein and First Ridden rider MUST stay mounted. STALLIONS- Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. Grooms must be 16 years of age and correctly Dressed. Judges are NOT allowed to groom for a SSADL competitor. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to Grand Finals, unless special circumstances should arise, then it will be left to the discretion of the Directors and Advisory Committee to oversee this rule if required. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same whether side saddle or astride from First/Second or Direct Route Qualifiers and Grand Final.
