

SHOW INFORMATION

The cross country is available to walk on Saturday 9th May from 2-7pm and on Sunday morning before the competition starts. For those who cannot make either of these times (and are jumping late on Sunday) we will organise a course walk in the afternoon. We regret that due to safety reasons we are not able to allow course walking while the competition is underway.

Show Jumping can be walked throughout the day at the start of each group of riders. Please ask the ring steward for further information.

All times will set in advance of the show.

Cross country is judged with an optimum time (set at a steady hunting canter). Faults will be awarded as 20 for the first refusal, 40 for the second refusal and an elimination for 3 refusals or a fall. In the event of an elimination riders will be asked to move onto the next fence or leave the course at the nearest exit (on foot, leading the horse if it was a rider fall). This will be indicated by a whistle blown by the nearest jump judge. A time limit of 20 seconds will be allowed for horse and rider to enter the water. If unable to enter the water within the 20 second time limit, the rider will incur 50 faults and will be asked to move onto the next fence.

Riders must wear a body protector and hat without a fixed peak for the cross country.

OPTIONAL WATER – the water will be optional for all classes. There will be an alternative route with 'joker' fence for those who either choose not to attempt the water OR those who incur faults at the water and are unable to go through it

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge. Those wishing to join or renew with the Society will need to apply for this before 1st May each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged. Regional Finals are open to members only. All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK, Lincolnshire 4th – 6th September 2026. No qualification or membership necessary.
