RING 1 ~ RIDDEN SHOWING

10am start

1a. ABSOLUTE NOVICE / TINY TOTS LEAD REIN

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 7 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. GENUINE ABSOLUTE NOVICES ONLY PLEASE!

1b. LEAD REIN

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under on 1st January. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

2. FIRST RIDDEN

Pony not exceeding 132cms. Riders 12 years or under.

3. FAMILY HORSE/PONY

Horse/Pony any height. To be ridden by two members of the same family. One can be on the lead rein

4. WALK & TROT NOVICE – *may be split if sufficient entries*

Open to any novice showing combination inc. lead rein & first ridden.

Walk & trot only inc. individual show.

Combination not to have been placed 1st in a showing class before 2026

5. RIDDEN NOVICE (Will not canter as a group)

Combination not to have been placed 1st in a showing class before 2026

6. RIDDEN COLOURED – Rider may be led

7. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Rider may be led

8. RIDDEN COB / COB TYPE – Rider may be led

9. SHOW HUNTER / RIDING HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led

10. RIDDEN VETERAN – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP TO FOLLOW

(for 1st & 2nd place from classes 1-10)

RING 1 ~ IN-HAND SHOWING

To follow the Ridden classes (so will be during the afternoon)

11. YOUNGSTOCK

Open to any horse or pony 3 years & under. Rosette to 'Best Yearling'

12. BEST COLOURED HORSE/PONY (IN-HAND)

Paints, spots, roans, duns, palominos, skewbald and piebald

13. SHOW RING EXPERIENCE (IN-HAND)

For horses/ponies not placed 1st in a showing class before 2026

14. HORSE/PONY 4yrs & OVER – Open to any horse or pony 4yrs +

15. IN-HAND MARE

16. JUNIOR HANDLER (IN-HAND) - Handler 16yrs & under

17. MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND (IN-HAND)

May be split into Small & Large breeds

18. IN-HAND GELDING/COLT/STALLION

19. BEST VETERAN (IN-HAND) – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +

IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP TO FOLLOW

(for 1st & 2nd place from classes 11-19)

RING 2 ~ SHOW JUMPING

Jumping will start at 10am

20. **Clear Round Jumping** (Bottom Hole Cross Poles) **£6**

Classes 21 to 31 ~ £14.00 each (via Equo) or £15.00 each if by cash/card

21. **Cross Poles Double Clear Round**

All double clears equal 1st. Jump Off not timed. CAN BE "ON FOOT" (WITHOUT A HORSE) OR MOUNTED ON A HORSE OR "ON FOOT" WITH DOG ON LEAD.

22. **Cross Poles RIDE & RUN**

Rider jumps fences 1-8 as usual, then dismounts and jumps 9-14 on foot

23. **Bottom Hole Jumping**

Absolute Novice combinations ONLY

24. **30-40cm Absolute Novice Jumping**

Absolute Novice combinations ONLY

25. **40-50cm Beginners Jumping**

26. **55cm Show Jumping**

27. **60cm Small Open Jumping**

27b. **60cm BARE BACK JUMPING**

28. **70cm "Quantum Photographic" Show Jumping**

29. **75cm Show Jumping**

30. **80-85cm Show Jumping**

31. **PUISSANCE** – starting at 60cm
