RING 1 ~ SHOW JUMPING

9am – 9.30am Clear Round (Cross Poles) £6 per round

Standard classes £14.00 each if entered via Equo (otherwise £15)

1. Cross Poles Jumping (Double Clear)

Riders may be led – Two Phase. All double clears equal 1st (jump off not timed). Genuine absolute novices only.

1b. Cross Poles RIDE & RUN

Riders may be led – Two Phase. Rider jumps fences 1-8 then dismounts and jumps 'jump off' on foot. Fastest clear wins!

2. Bottom Hole Absolute Novice Jumping

Riders any age. Complete novices Only

3. 30-40cm Absolute Novice Jumping

Riders any age. Complete novices Only

4. 40-50cm Mini Jumping

5. 55cm Jumping

6. 60cm Small Open Jumping

26. TINY TOTS LEAD REIN PONY

Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 7years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband

27. LEAD REIN PONY Pony not exceeding 128cms. Riders 9 years or under. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to noseband .

28. JUNIOR RIDDEN (Will not canter as a group)

Pony not exceeding 148cms. Riders 16 years or under.

29. FIRST RIDDEN (Will not canter as a group) Pony not exceeding 134cms. Riders 12 years or under.

SSADL LIHS CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES 11a-c AND 30a-c

31. WALK & TROT NOVICE - May be split into junior/senior if entries permit

Open to any novice showing combination inc. lead rein & first ridden. Walk & trot only inc. individual show. Riders may enter both 31 & 32

32. RIDDEN NOVICE (Will not canter as a group)

Combination not to have been placed 1st in a showing class before 2026

33. RIDDEN COLOURED – Rider may be led

34. RIDDEN COB / COB TYPE – Rider may be led

35. RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Rider may be led

36. RIDING /SHOW HUNTER HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led. Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over (may be split in ring)

37. RIDDEN VETERAN – Open to any horse or pony 15yrs +
Rider may be led. WILL NOT BE REQUIRED TO GALLOP

38. RIDING CLUB HORSE or PONY – Rider may be led
Mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Will include one small fence in individual show

39. CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE - Ridden/In Hand

SSADL LIHS DIRECT ROUTE QUALIFIERS

DIRECT ROUTE QUALIFIERS – Are open to Members and Non-members HOWEVER, to claim the LIHS ticket a competitor MUST already be a 2026 member. The members MUST produce the membership card or a covering letter from the SSAD Show office to be able to claim the LIHS Ticket. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same for the Grand Final, unless under special circumstances, on such an occasion the directors may deem it fit to alter said rule. No substitutions will be accepted. For a competitor to be eligible to compete at the LIHS Senior Showing Grand Final at the XCELL, ALL ponies/horses MUST meet the current FEI Vaccination Regulations.

NOTE -ONCE A COMPETITOR HAS QUALIFIED FOR LIHS IN THE RIDDEN SECTION, THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO QUALIFY IN THE IN-HAND SECTION AND VICE VERSA.

Competitors MUST produce both the above cards at the ring side before entry NO CARDS NO ENTRY

No Spurs with the exception to senior side saddle riders. No Galloping or canter extensions, Riders/Handlers -No Wearing of Face/Body Jewellery with the exception to the earring used by competitors with health problems. Foals are NOT permitted SSADL Classes. For In-Hand Classes- Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein & First Ridden competitors: Strip section both lead rein and First Ridden rider MUST stay mounted.

STALLIONS- Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. Grooms must be 16 years of age and correctly Dressed. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to Grand Finals, unless special circumstances should arise, then it will be left to the discretion of the Directors and Advisory Committee to oversee this rule if required. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same whether side saddle or astride from First/Second or Direct Route Qualifiers and Grand Final.

SSADL AGE BADGES MUST BE WORN BY MEMBERS, FAILURE TO DO WILL DEEM DISQUALIFICATION.
